Carolyn was born in Sacramento and grew up in San Francisco; St. Paul, Minnesota; Augusta, Georgia; Portland, Oregon and Olympia, Washington where she met Alan in high school. She entered Washington State University. but left after one year to marry and move around the US with Alan and their family of three daughters. They finally settled in Saratoga in 1966 where they have lived except for two years living in Linlithgow, Scotland.

When her girls were in school, Carolyn went back to West Valley College and graduated as valedictorian of her class. She then worked for the Saratoga News, and for 20 years for the city of Saratoga, retiring as Assistant City Manager. Since retiring she has served on the Saratoga Heritage Commission and on the boards of the Friends of the Saratoga Libraries and the Girl Scouts.

The Kings' daughters live in Santa Cruz; Portland, Oregon; and Chapel Hill, North Carolina. They have four grandchildren. Carolyn and Alan enjoyed traveling and visited at least 69 countries, on their own or with Alumni groups. The Kings moved to SRC in 2007 and Carolyn died in the Health Care Center.
