

Ed Spykerman 11-27-1927 to 4-13-2001

Ed was born and raised in Grand Rapids, MI and went on to get an Engineering degree at Tri-State University in Angola, IN. During WWII he served in the Army and after that he worked for Douglas Aircraft in Santa Monica, CA, Canoga Corp. in Canoga Park, CA and retired in 1994 as a systems engineer at Lockheed where he worked for 36 years. He met his wife Dotty when she attended Grand Rapids Junior College and they married in 1951. They came to CA in 1953 and moved to Sunnyvale in 1958. They became real estate brokers and owned their own agency. They also owned and managed properties and buildings in the Bay Area and around the country.
