He worked on satellite communications with NATO and the Army, retiring after 28 years.

When that marriage was dissolved, she supported herself and two little children working at GE, where she retired after 30 years of employment.

He organized, built dioramas, and became a docent at the Truckee-Donner Railroad Museum near their second home in Truckee.
