



**Stephanie (Stevie) Day**  
April 26, 1936 to Oct. 21, 2022

Stevie was born in Kalamazoo, Michigan and studied psychology at Wellesley College in Massachusetts. She met her husband, John Day, at a fraternity mixer in Boston and after his Army service they were married in 1959. They moved to Mountain View and Stevie went to San Jose State University to earn her teaching credential. She then taught fifth grade in Los Altos.

Stevie was a stay at home mom while their two daughters were young. As a volunteer, she helped organize the Art Docent Program for the Los Altos School District, which has continued for more than 40 years. She was active in organizing the Children's Health Awareness Council (CHAC) where she taught courses in parent-child communications. Later she returned to teach grades 5 and 6 in the Los Altos School District. They lived in Los Altos for 52 years until moving to SRC.

At SRC since March 2015, Stevie enjoyed tai chi, water exercises, needlework and reading. She was also interested in collecting American Indian baskets and pottery. While John enjoyed adventure travel, she preferred shopping in New York City, dining in New Orleans and visiting art galleries. She also enjoyed her four grandchildren. She died on Oct. 21, 2022.
