Anne was born and raised in Northampton, Massachusetts, where she also graduated from Smith College with a degree in chemistry. After she and Charlie were married in 1956, she worked for seven years at Arthur D. Little, Inc. in Cambridge, doing food chemistry and taste-panel measurements in the Food and Flavor Lab. She was also granted two patents during this time.

The Nowlins moved to Oak Ridge, Tennessee in 1963 where Anne became a full-time mother, Scout and Camp Fire Girl leader and investment club trainer. When the children approached the teen years, she went back to school getting an MS in psychology from the University of Tennessee in Knoxville. She then taught for 19 years at both UTK and local community colleges.
