Marilyn was born and raised in San Francisco. She met her husband Bob on a blind date. After they were married, they moved to Pacifica after their first child was born. After their second child was in school, Marilyn returned to UC Berkeley to earn her BA while working 30 hours a week at Bank of America. Six years later she earned her MBA from Berkeley's evening program. She stayed with B of A for 20 years, but in 1989 went into retail management which led to her opening a neighborhood specialty coffee shop in San Bruno. She and Bob ran the "Bump and Grind" in Bayhill Shopping Center seven days a week for seven years. That led to early retirement when they moved into a cottage at SRC in the Pioneer group on Jan. 5. 2005.

They downsized to 4210 in 2019. They then became unofficial "hosts" of the beforedinner wine group at the Tavern. Marilyn enjoyed music, bridge, her pets, and travel to China, Italy, England, Germany, and Japan.
